AMENDED RETURNS

23. Amount paid with original return, plus additional tax paid after it was filed 23 ▶

24. Add line 23 from above and line 24 from Form 760 and enter here 24

25. Overpayment, if any, as shown on original return or as previously adjusted 25 ▶

26. Subtract line 25 from line 24 26

27. If line 26 above is less than line 17, Form 760, subtract line 26 above from line 17, Form 760. This is the **Tax You Owe**. 27 ▶

28. Refund. If line 17, Form 760 is less than line 26 above, subtract line 17, Form 760 from line 26 above. This is the **Tax You Overpaid** 28 ▶

To have your refund deposited directly to your bank, copy the Refund Amount on line 28 above to Form 760, line 31 and fill in the Direct Deposit information
