Part I AGE DEDUCTION FOR TAXPAYERS AGE 62 AND OVER FOR FORM 760PY ONLY
Nonresident filers may use Form 763 to compute the age deduction.

(Each spouse computes this deduction separately.)

If you qualify for this deduction and the disability income subtraction on Form 760PY, Part III, line 41, claim the one which benefits you the most. You may not claim both.

1. Enter your DATE of BIRTH (For example: 03-04-30) 1.
2. If age 62, 63 or 64 by midnight, January 1, 2001, enter \$6,000
OR if age 65 or over by midnight, January 1, 2001, enter \$12,000 2.
3. Enter the Ratio Schedule amount for the date you moved to Virginia
or out of Virginia 3.
4. **QUALIFYING AGE DEDUCTION.** Multiply line 2 by line 3 and enter here 4.

Filing Status 1 or 3: Enter amount from line 4, column B on Form 760PY, line 36, column B.
Filing Status 2: Add line 4, column A and column B above, and enter the total in column B on Form 760PY, line 36.
Filing Status 4: Enter amount(s) from line 4 in column A and column B above, on Form 760PY, line 36.

PART II - CREDIT FOR TAX PAID TO ANOTHER STATE - Attach a copy of the other state's return.

1. Qualifying taxable income on which the other state's tax is based.
Read the instructions before completing this line 1.
2. Virginia taxable income. Enter amount from line 15 of Form 760PY, or line 17 of Form 763 ... 2.
3. Qualifying tax paid to the other state. See instructions.
Enter name of state: _____ 3.
4. Virginia income tax. Enter amount from line 16 of Form 760PY minus line 18(e) of Form 760PY
or line 18 of Form 763 minus line 19(d) of Form 763. 4.
5. Income percentage. Compute to one decimal place, not to exceed 100%
For example, 0.3163 becomes 31.6%. If filing Form 760PY,
divide line 1 by line 2. If filing Form 763, divide line 2 by line 1. 5.
6. Form 760PY filers multiply line 5 by line 4.
Form 763 filers multiply line 5 by line 3 6.
7. CREDIT. Form 760PY filers enter the lesser of line 3 or line 6.
Form 763 filers enter the lesser of line 4 or line 6 7.
8. TOTAL. Add the amounts from line 7, column A and line 7, column B. Enter here
and on line 18(f) of Form 760PY or line 19(e) of Form 763 8.

Part III ADDITION TO TAX, PENALTY AND INTEREST (See instructions.)

1. Addition to tax: Enter amount from Form 760C or Form 760F, whichever is applicable 1.
2. Penalty: See instructions. If owed, check: Late Filing Penalty OR Extension Penalty and enter amount 2.
3. Interest: Compute on amount from Form 763, line 21 or Form 760PY, line 20 (See instructions) 3.
4. TOTAL (add lines 1, 2 and 3). Enter here and on Form 763, line 23, or Form 760PY, line 22 4.

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
