- Claim Number Assignment File
- Match File
- Match Update Errors File
- Pre-Default Update/Contest Date File
- Payment Information File
- Defaulted Match File

The templates currently exist on the TAX LMS system.

- Use this task only if the file data is needed in a format other than provided on the file or the file cannot be processed.
- Knowledge of Excel spreadsheets and importing data into a spreadsheet is needed to perform this task.

- 5. Import the file into the template following Excel import instructions.
- 6. Save the populated template to the file designated by your agency.

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
