8 CHAPTER: VIEW EXTERNAL OFFSETS IN PROGRESS

From the IRMS main window, you can view External Offsets (Matches) in Progress using the External Offsets in Progress window. The External Offsets in Progress window displays a list of only the claims where money has been offered, but the match has NOT been finalized.

To be displayed on this window, the matched claim status must be one of the following:

- Pending Default
- Active
- Certified
- Contested

Note: Once the claim is finalized, it is removed from the External Claims in Progress window, and the match history is recorded on the Claim Detail window.

You can also use the External Offsets in Progress window to access the Certify-Contest External Offset and the Finalize External Offset windows. Once you enter data in this window, you can select the Certify, Contest, or Finalize buttons. The information will carry over to these windows and does not have to be re-entered.


Note: The Virginia Department of Taxation will attempt to notify your agency's Set-Off Debt Coordinator (SODC) when a claim is matched, and when a default date is approaching. However, there is no guarantee the email will be delivered, or that your SODC is available to work on the claim at that time.

It is very important for someone at your agency to check the External Offsets In Progress window at least once a week to make sure there are no matches in danger of default.

Once a match has defaulted, the money is returned to the customer or applied to another claim. It is no longer available to settle the debt to your agency.

External Offsets in Progress Window

External Offsets in Progress Fields


The table below lists the fields in the External Offsets in Progress window and provides a brief description of each.

| Field | Field Type | Description |
|--------------------|---------------------|--|
| Agency Number | Required | Unique, assigned number of the Set-Off Agency. This number is provided by TAX. |
| Pending Default | Optional | Selecting this option displays only those claims with a date that is eligible to default within the next seven calendar days. This option can be combined with any other selection option. |
| Active | Optional | Selecting this option displays only those claims that are active (i.e., not finalized, defaulted, nor withdrawn). This option can be combined with any other selection option. |
| Certified | Optional | Selecting this option displays only those claims for which the taxpayer has been notified. This option can be combined with any other selection option. |
| Contested | Optional | Selecting this option displays only those claims that are being appealed (or contested) by the taxpayer. This option can be combined with any other selection option. |
| Claim Name | System Generated | Name of the taxpayer identified by the SSN/FEIN. |

| Field | Field Type | Description |
|------------------------------|---------------------|--|
| External ID | System Generated | Social Security Number (SSN) or Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN) of the taxpayer. |
| Claim Number | System Generated | Unique number automatically assigned to the claim by the system. |
| Claim Status | System Generated | Current status of the claim in the set-off process (such as Open, Matched, or Deleted). |
| Amount | System Generated | Amount of the claim. |
| Match Date | System Generated | Date a match was made to the claim. |
| Match Status | System Generated | Current status of the match (such as Pending Default, Active, Certified, or Contested). |
| Match ID | System Generated | Nine-digit number that uniquely identifies the external offset/match. |
| Date Eligible for Default | System Generated | Date that the external offset will become eligible for default. |


View External Offsets in Progress

To view the External Offsets in Progress window, the following steps are performed:



Step 1: From the IRMS Main window, select: <u>Tax Information: Setoffs: External Offsets in Progress</u>.

The system displays the External Offsets in Progress window.




- **Step 2:** Enter your assigned **Agency Number**.
- **Step 3:** To reduce the number of claims displayed, select one or more of the status options to filter the number and type of claims displayed on the window.



Note: For example, selecting the Pending Default option will display only those claims with a date that is eligible to default within the next seven calendar days. On the other hand, selecting both the Certified and Contested options will display claims for which the taxpayer has been notified, as well as those that are being contested.

Step 4: Click Find.

The External Offsets window displays the outstanding claims for your agency.





Note: Using the buttons along the bottom of the window, you can select a match and the match. Or, you can select a match and access the Finalize External Offset window to **Finalize** the match.

Step 5: Click Close to exit the External Offsets in Progress window and return to the IRMS main window.
